Golden hour magic

Aim foe a session during the golden hour - either half an hour before or an hour before sunset.

This time provides a soft, flattering light that enhances the natural beauty of the setting and offers that soughtafter golden glow.

Afternative to Golden hour

If shooting during golden hour isn't feasible, consider overcast days which can also provide diffused light that is even and flattering, eliminating harsh shadows and glaring highlights.

Utilizing a sun calculator

Leverage tools like a Sun Calc to pinpoint the optimal shooting times specific to your location. These apps provide precise timings for sunrise, sunset, and golden hours, allowing for perfect planning according to natural lighting conditions.

Avoiding crowds




